## Australian Masters 2015 - Ticket Terms and Conditions

- 1. This ticket may not, without the prior written consent of the official event ticketing agency and International Management Group of America Pty Limited (the "Event Organiser"), be resold or offered for sale at a premium (including via on-line auction sites) or used for advertising, promotion or other commercial purposes (including competitions and trade promotions) or to enhance the demand for other goods or services, either by the original purchaser or any subsequent bearer. If a ticket is sold or used in breach of this condition, the ticket may be cancelled without a refund and the bearer of the ticket may be refused admission.
- 2. Use of mobile phones at the venue is not permitted other than in designated areas and by officials working at the 2015 Australian Masters (the "Tournament") and for persons specifically authorized by the Event Organiser. You agree to comply with all notices at the venue and all directions from the Event Organiser, including directions from course marshals in relation to silence whilst players hit, roped areas and other matters. You may be removed from the venue if you do not comply with any direction from the Event Organiser or its representatives. Your co-operation is greatly appreciated.
- 3. Tickets are not refundable or subject to exchange unless required by law. You are responsible for your tickets and lost, stolen or damaged tickets are not the responsibility of the Event Organiser. However, you may seek replacement of a lost, stolen or damaged ticket at the Venue Box Office. In the event that the Venue Box Office issues a Lost Ticket Voucher in its discretion, an administration fee of \$10 will be charged. If a day's play is cancelled after it has started (for example, because of bad weather), and more than 2 hours of play have occurred throughout the day, you cannot exchange your ticket and you cannot obtain a refund. If the description of, or participants in, the Tournament change, you cannot exchange your ticket and you cannot obtain a refund. The Event Organiser is not liable to you for any claims, damages, compensation, losses or expenses as a result of the Tournament or days of the Tournament being cancelled, postponed or changed.
- 4. You understand that the layout of the venue may be unfamiliar to you, so you must take care at all times. You acknowledge that you are responsible for your own safety and for the safety of any children accompanying you. Ticket holders enter the venue at their own risk. The Event Organiser advises that due to the uneven and, in parts, steep terrain of this course it may at times be difficult for spectators to move around freely and easily, as a result of which, it may not be suitable for those spectators who suffer from certain medical conditions. You are advised to wear suitable fortwear and to be careful in moving around the golf course.
- 5. You assume all risk and danger incidental to the game of golf and to the extent permitted by law you release the Professional Golfers Association of Australia Limited (the "PGA Tour") and its subsidiaries, the Event Organiser (including their directors, officers, employees, consultants, contractors, agents and volunteers), the host broadcaster, the PGA Tour's sponsors, the Event Organiser's sponsors, the host broadcast's sponsors, participating players and all of their agents from any liability for any damage, loss, liability or injury you may suffer in relation to your attendance at the Tournament and the assumption of such risk and danger howsoever caused including without limitation being struck by a golf ball or due to any negligence or other act or omission of the Event Organiser or its representatives, agents, contractors and/or volunteers. You agree to compensate the Event Organiser for any damage, loss, liability or injury the Event Organiser may suffer as a result of your wilful, reckless or negligent acts or omissions at the Tournament.
  - 6. You grant permission to the Event Organiser and the PGA Tour and their licensees to use your image or likeness in relation to any live or recorded television or other media transmission or reproduction in whole or in part of the Tournament.
  - 7. A separate parking ticket is required for access to official Tournament car parks.
  - 8. These ticket terms and conditions may be supplemented by additional terms and conditions displayed at the venue.
  - 9. No cameras, video or audio equipments, PDA's, radios, televisions, large eskies, stepladders, signs, banners, firearms, explosive devices, etc will be permitted on the grounds of the Tournament. You agree not to transmit or facilitate transmission of any account, description, picture or reproduction of the Tournament other than for private domestic purposes (that is, you cannot sell, license, broadcast, publish or otherwise commercially exploit them) without the written consent of the Event Organiser and the PGA Tour. In particular you may not make available any moving footage, sound recordings or series of still pictures taken at the Tournament on the internet or to mobile devices via mobile wireless technology. All mobile phones/pagers must be turned off whilst in the venue unless otherwise authorised, or located in an area where use is permitted by the Event Organiser.
  - 10. No alcoholic beverages or glass bottles may be brought onto or taken from the grounds of the

Tournament. Only sealed plastic bottles may be brought into the grounds of the Tournament. Pets are not permitted within the grounds of the Tournament.

- 11. You are responsible for your own property whilst at the venue.
- 12. Soliciting autographs from Tournament players with the intent to sell is prohibited. You agree that you shall not seek autographs of players in order to sell such autographs, and you shall not pay another person to obtain an autograph for you.
- 13. You hereby consent to the reasonable inspection of your person and property before entering the Tournament, which inspection may include, without limitation, metal detection.
- 14. Tickets (and badges if applicable) shall be liable to be surrendered to the Event Organiser (and the holder removed from, or refused access to, the grounds of the Tournament) if, in the opinion of the Event Organiser (who shall at all times act reasonably in the exercise of their discretion), the behaviour of the holder is, or could be considered to be dangerous, offensive, a nuisance or annoyance to other spectators, players, Tournament officials, marshals and/or security personnel, for example, if the holder appears to be under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs and/or is acting aggressively, or if the holder fails to obey any conditions of use, posted signs or instructions of Tournament officials, marshals and/or security personnel including, without limitation, any verbal or written instructions or prohibition on the use of mobile telephones, other electronic communication equipment, cameras, video, sound or image recorders and/or global positioning systems or similar positioning, tracking or measurement devices. Any person who is refused admission to the Tournament under these circumstances will be entitled to a full refund for their ticket. Any person who is removed from the Tournament under these circumstances after gaining entry will not be entitled to a refund of their ticket price.
- 15. The Event Organiser may refuse you entry into, or remove you from, the venue if you do not obey these terms and conditions, you interfere with the enjoyment, comfort or safety of other persons at the Tournament, you have a lost, stolen, counterfeit, damaged or unreadable ticket or you have acquired your ticket from an unauthorised source, or the Event Organiser reasonably suspects you of any of the above.
