VENUE & SHOW INFORMATION

BOX OFFICE Ticket purchase and Ticketmaster collections will be available from the box offices located at Gates 2, 3 and 7. The Customer Service Centre outside Gate 2 will be open from 9.00am on the day of the show only. However, to avoid queues on the day patrons are encouraged to collect their pre-purchased tickets in advance from a Ticketmaster outlet. ENTRY GATES Please refer to the gate number printed on your ticket. Patrons must occupy the seat or area specified on their concert ticket.

SECURITY & SEARCH ON ENTRY You and/or your possessions may be subject to a safety and security search upon entry. Prohibited items include, but are not limited to, the list at the end of this sheet. Any prohibited items will be confiscated and will not be returned, replaced or reimbursed. The movement of patrons on the Etihad Stadium site is subject to monitoring by security cameras. Patrons may be filmed/photographed.

CLOAKROOM FACILITIES There will be an external cloakroom facility located at Gate 5. Merchandise, consumables and prohibited items cannot be cloaked.

PASS-OUTS Pass-outs will be available at the concert, as long as patrons are in possession of their valid event ticket upon exit and re-entry to the venue.

FIRST AID First Aid positions are located at Level B2 Ring Road, Aisle 2 (Main Office), Level 1 Aisle 40, Level 2 Aisle 40, Level 3 Aisle 17 and 41.

TOILETS Are located at various positions around the stadium.

ATM/EFTPOS FACILITIES ATMs are located at Level 1, Gate 2 (internal and external), Gate 1 (internal), Gate 7 (internal), Level 2 Gate 9, and Level 3, Aisles 8 and 32. However, to avoid queues on the night patrons are advised to come prepared with sufficient cash for the entire evening.

FOOD & BEVERAGE FACILITIES A range of catering outlets will be available along with bar service. Proof of age photo ID is required to purchase or consume alcohol, and service will not be provided to people less than 18 years of age or intoxicated patrons. The venue reserves the right to deny entry to and/or evict intoxicated patrons or under-age patrons found with alcohol. No alcohol can be removed from Etihad Stadium. EFTPOS facilities will not be available at the food and beverage outlets.

SMOKING Etihad Stadium is a smoke-free venue. Smoking is not permitted within the venue or in the designated smoke-free areas outside.

WEATHER The concert is planned to be an open-air event, but this will be subject to any inclement weather conditions. No umbrellas are allowed to be put up whilst in the venue, so bring a raincoat or poncho if inclement weather is predicted.

GETTING TO & FROM THE CONCERT

TRAIN SERVICES Southern Cross is the nearest train station to Etihad Stadium and is approximately a four-minute walk across the Bourke Street pedestrian footbridge. Train timetable information is available from Connex Melbourne on 1800 800 705 or metrotrains.com.au

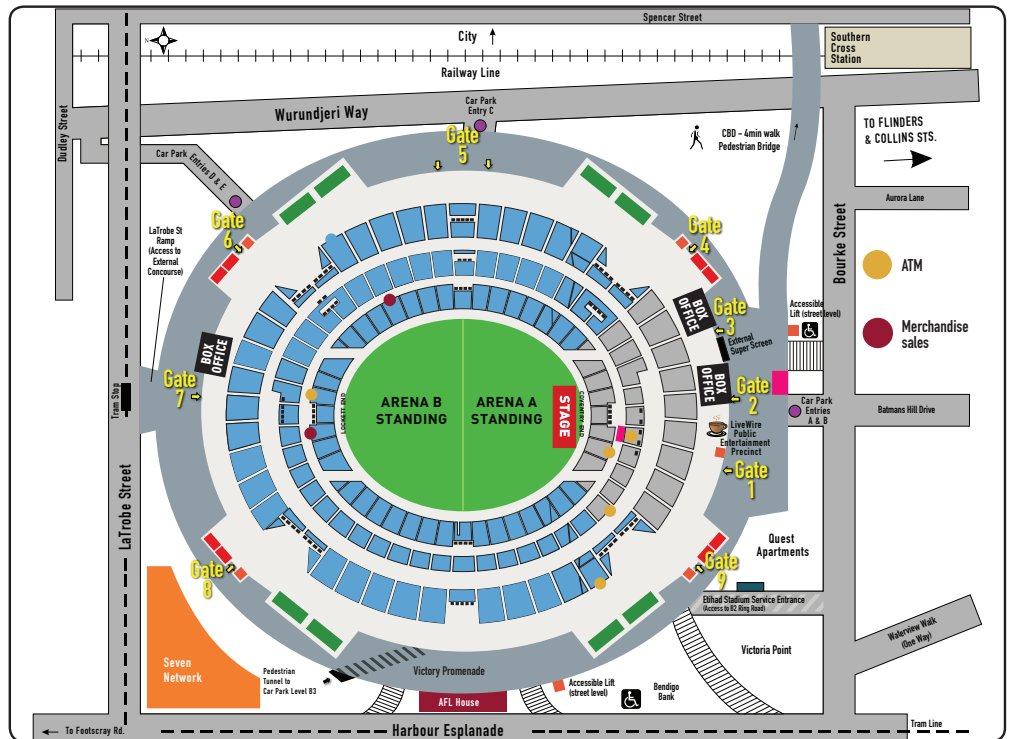
TRAM SERVICES Trams run to Etihad Stadium from La Trobe Street and Harbour Esplanade. Trams also stop in the CBD on Spencer Street, Bourke Street and Collins Street and all are a short walk to Etihad Stadium. Tram timetable information is available from metlinkmelbourne.com.au.

BUS SERVICES The bus terminus is located at Southern Cross Train Station and services airport transfers as well as routes across country Victoria. Etihad Stadium is a short walk across the Bourke Street pedestrian footbridge from the bus terminus.

TAXIS The nearest taxi rank to Etihad Stadium is located outside Car Parks A and B, adjacent to the NAB building on the Bourke Street extension. Please note, taxis are not permitted to enter any of Etihad Stadium's Car Park entry points, as these are non-stopping areas. Taxis with mobility-impaired patrons can access Etihad Stadium's Car Parks.

ROAD CLOSURES The following road closures will be in place for the concert:

- La Trobe Street closed in both directions between Harbour Esplanade and Spencer Street.
- Spencer Street closed in both directions between Collins Street and Lansdale Street.
- Collins Street closed in the East bound direction between Batman's Hill Drive and Spencer Street.
- Bourke Street, Lt Collins Street and Francis Street, all closed at Spencer Street.



MOBILITY-IMPAIRED ACCESS For the mobility-impaired, Etihad Stadium offers various options for access. Fully equipped lifts are located at the steps on the external concourse at the Bourke Street entrance and on Harbour Esplanade.

There are also lifts operating from each level of the underground Car Park to each level of the stadium. The Car Park has 52 designated parking bays for mobility-impaired persons. Additional public parking is available at Victoria Harbour.

PARKING FACILITIES Over 2,500 undercover car parking spaces are available at the venue. The costs for event day parking are: pre-paid \$25.00 plus booking fee; or, pay on entry \$25.00 flat rate.

DROP OFF/PICK UP POINT Access can also be gained off La Trobe Street (Gate 7), Harbour Esplanade (Gates 8 and 9) and Bourke Street (Gates 1, 2 and 3).

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Please note that conditions are subject to change without notice and may vary from event to event. The venue and promoter reserve the right to deny entry to, or evict, any person.

PROHIBITED**

- Video cameras
- Professional cameras (with detachable lenses)
- Audio recording devices of any kind
- Cans
- Glass of any kind
- Strictly NO alcohol
- Commercially prepared food or beverages
- Open drink containers
- Metal utensils, cutlery etc
- Illegal substances
- Laser pointing devices, flares or fireworks
- Long chains or spikes/studs of any nature
- Offensive weapons including, but not limited to, any object that may be used as a projectile such as glow sticks, balls, containers etc
- Air horns, loud hailers or whistles
- Musical instruments

- Umbrellas are permitted inside Etihad Stadium, however, cannot be opened within Etihad Stadium
- Other sun/rain shelters
- Chairs or stools
- Skateboards, rollerblades, bicycles or scooters
- Unauthorised temporary signage and promotional products
- Flags/banners with handles exceeding 1.6 metres
- Any large items that cannot be placed under a seat without impeding access
- Animals (other than Assistance dogs)
- Any other items deemed to be illegal, dangerous or a nuisance to yourself or others

** Please note that prohibited items may be confiscated so if in doubt leave it at home or in your car. Venue and Promoter take no responsibility for confiscated items.

PERMITTED

- Small personal cameras and camera phones are allowed. Professional cameras with detachable lenses are not.
- Sun hat and sunscreen
- Jacket/poncho for inclement weather
- Sealed plastic bottles of water (lids will be removed upon entry for Arena A & Arena B GA Standing patrons)
- Prams, pushers, eskies, bags and other belongings are permitted into Etihad Stadium, however, must be able to fit safely under the patron's seat without impeding access.

ARENA A & ARENA B GA STANDING CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Arena A and Arena B GA Standing areas are not recommended for children under 12 years
- Stadium terms and conditions of entry and restricted items apply
- Patrons must enter through the gate listed on their tickets
- Dangerous activities such as aggressive moshing, stage diving, crowd surfing and climbing are not permitted and may result in the removal of patrons from the event
- Patrons cannot move between Arena A and Arena B areas
