

# **NIGHT MARKET | CARRIAGEWORKS**

## **IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR TICKETHOLDERS**

This guide aims to give you all the information you need about the Night Market to ensure an enjoyable experience.

### **ENTRY AND TICKETS**

#### **ENTRY AND ADMISSION**

There are two entry points to the Night Market. Ticket holders may enter via the main Carriageworks stairs at 245 Wilson Street, Eveleigh or via Carriageworks Way accessed by 229 Wilson Street. If you are collecting your tickets head to the Night Market box office located at 255 Wilson Street. All tickets will be scanned at entry. Location map can be found [here](#).

The Night Market is free for children under 12, who do not require a ticket when accompanied by an adult holding a ticket.

#### **PRINT AT HOME, MAIL AND MOBILE TICKETS**

If you have received your tickets via mail, selected the Print-at-Home option or chosen eTicket delivery, you can make your way straight to one of the main entrances with your phone and/or printed tickets ready on display.

#### **VENUE COLLECTION TICKETS**

If you selected 'Venue Pickup' your tickets will be available for collection from the Night Market Box Office located at 255 Wilson St from 2pm onwards on Friday the 27<sup>th</sup> of July.

To avoid queuing for ticket collections we recommend downloading, printing or collecting your tickets prior to arriving at the event.

#### **NO PASSOUTS**

There are no pass outs once you enter the Night Market.

### **TRANSPORT AND GETTING HERE**

#### **PUBLIC TRANSPORT**

Carriageworks is located at 245 Wilson St, Eveleigh 2015 (an 8 minute walk from Redfern Station and 10 minute walk from Macdonaldtown Station). Catching public transport is strongly recommended with strictly limited residential parking in the area. #### **ACCESSIBILITY**

We welcome all visitors to the Night Market and ensure our venues and events are accessible as possible. Carriageworks is wheelchair accessible. The ramp leading to the main entrance is accessed on street level via Wilson St. Accessible parking is available via 229 Wilson St (end of Carriageworks Way). The closest train station with wheelchair access is Newtown Station. Taxis can enter at 229 Wilson St (opposite Queen St) for level access entry.

#### **ALL WEATHER EVENT**

The Night Market is an all-weather and undercover Market. The event will proceed, rain, hail or shine. The weather forecast is predicting a little early evening rain with a top temperature of 16 degrees.

#### **ALL AGES LICENSED EVENT**

The Night Market is a family-friendly event and free for children under 12. Please note patrons under the age of 18 years must be accompanied by a responsible adult. The event is fully licensed and ID must be shown on request to purchase alcohol.

### **STALLHOLDERS**

Fifty-five of Sydney's leading restaurants, bars and producers will present menus evocative of the theme ***Burning Love***, using smoke and spice, careful slow-cooking, heat and flame to showcase locally-sourced seasonal produce prepared by some of Australia's best chefs at the leading edge of their practice. ### **SCHEDULE OF LIVE DEMONSTRATIONS**

Alongside an abundance of delicious food and drinks, don't miss the opportunity to sample dishes from leading chefs using fire, smoke and coal, including; Traditional Aboriginal firemaking and cooking techniques from Dwayne Bannon Harrison of Ngaran Ngaran Cultural Awareness along with a traditional dance; wood smoked cobia on the fire demonstration by seafood legends Stephen Hodges and John Susman; and Ben and Elvis will be cooking eight hour wood fired crucified lamb, braised peas and chimichurri (available for purchase at their stall). \*Please note a selection of cooking demonstration samples will be offered, others will available be for purchase, all are limited.

### **MUSIC**

A red hot line-up of bands will amplify the theme. **The Van Demons**, a local garage four-piece inspired by the sounds of The Chantays, Surfari and Link Wray will bring authentic sounds of 1960's instrumental surf era to life, **JD and the Hunger Men**, will play country, blues, Americana, gypsy and rock with band-member **Ben Hay** DJ-ing throughout the evening.

### **WORTHY CAUSES**

In keeping with the Night Market's philosophy of celebration, collaboration and community, representatives from several community organisations including **Two Good Co.**, **OzHarvest**, **CWA Sydney City** and the **National Indigenous Culinary Institute** will feature at the Night Market.

### **FACILITIES: WATER, SEATING, ATMS AND BATHROOMS**

For this market, there will be plenty of seating, as well as accessible toilets and baby changing facilities on site.

Stallholders will clearly identify cash and card facilities. There will be 4 x ATMS onsite, we strongly recommend you bring cash with you as they can get busy.

We've partnered with [Sydney Water](#) to bring free water stations to the Night Market so that we can help reduce plastic waste. BYO reusable water bottles and keep an eye out for these on the night. You can refill as many times as you like.
