BOX OFFICE

The Aotea Centre Main Box Office is located on Level 3 of the Aotea Centre and is open Monday to Friday 9:00am to 5:30pm, Saturday and Sunday 10:00am to 4:00pm (excluding public holidays).

The Civic Box Office is located on the Wellesley Street side of theatre entrance and is open in season daily from 11:00am until one hour after the show commences. On non-performing days the box office closes at 5:30pm.

DURATION

MARY POPPINS runs approximately two hours and forty minutes, with a twenty minute interval.

FOOD & BEVERAGE

The Box Cafe and Bar is located on the Level 3 terrace of the Aotea Centre and is a terrific spot to enjoy coffees, drinks, and a light meal before or after the show. Hot and cold canapés, cheese and antipasto platters are also available. Pre-order by emailing hello@the-box.co.nz. The Box Cafe closes at 7:00pm most nights, open til late on Thursday and Friday*. The Civic bars open one hour prior to every performance and remain open for interval serving a wide range of beverages, along with snacks and ice creams.

GETTING THERE

TRAIN

The nearest railway station is the Britomart Transport Centre at the bottom of Queen Street. Exit the station at Queen St and hop on the City LINK (red) bus heading south on Queen St to arrive at The Civic. Buses leave from Britomart every few minutes. Alternatively walk south on Queen Street about 15 minutes (850 meters) to The Civic.

BUS

Buses run along Wellesley Street and Queen St and stop just outside the theatre. For more information on bus, ferry and train services visit <u>www.maxx.co.nz</u> or telephone 09 366 6400.

TAXI

The nearest taxi rank to The Civic is located directly opposite the venue on Wellesley Street, however all taxis will pick up and drop off passengers directly outside the theatre.

CARPARK

Parking is available at the Civic Car Park located directly below the Aotea Centre. Entry to the car park is from Greys Avenue or Mayoral Drive. After parking your vehicle, pre-pay your ticket to avoid long queues!

A limited number of pre-paid, reserved spaces are available and can be purchased in advance from the Aotea Centre Box Office or by calling 0800 BUY TICKETS. You must have your pre-paid ticket with you when you enter the car park so collect it first or have it posted. Reserved parks must be taken at least 30 minutes prior to the performance start time. On busy nights alternative parking is available at the Victoria Street car park.
