

## TICKETS TO THE 2012 PREMIER'S SENIORS WEEK GALA CONCERT

Please find enclosed your tickets to the 2012 Premier's Seniors Week Gala Concert. Keep your tickets in a safe place and remember to bring them with you to the concert.

The concert will be held at the Sydney Entertainment Centre on Monday 19 March, at both 10.30am and 2.30pm. **Please note the concert time and gate entry details on your ticket.**

Doors open 45 minutes prior to the starting time and the concert runs for approximately 1 hour and 45 minutes, including a short intermission.

If you are meeting people, it is recommended that you arrange to meet outside your allocated gate, prior to entering the venue. **Entry to the venue is not permitted without a ticket.**

Tickets to all concerts are scanned upon entry to the Sydney Entertainment Centre and measured against tickets booked by individuals. This process was implemented to identify unused tickets and minimise the number of empty seats in the auditorium each concert series.

### **Returning Tickets**
