

## **What do I need to know about Tash Sultana at Pineapple Fields, Sunshine Coast?**

It's just been announced that Tash Sultana will be playing one very special show at the Pineapple Fields on Queensland's Sunshine Coast on Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> January 2019.

The concert is being held in the beautifully grassed Pineapple Fields opposite The Big Pineapple Complex, on the Sunshine Coast, 76 Nambour Connection Road, Woombye, QLD and is **strictly over 18 only**.

Pre-sales commence at 9am local time Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> July. General Sales commence 9am local time Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> July.

We're sure you have a lot of questions, so we've prepared all the need-to-know info ahead of the show next Jan!

## **Travel**

### **Will there be camping at the festival site?**

YES! If you're travelling to the Tash concert from outside the Sunshine Coast and looking for a truly unique experience, then we've got you covered with our camping options. [Click here](#) for more information.

### **Can I park at The Big Pineapple?**

Parking at the festival site is no longer available. However, you can park at one of the designated areas around the Sunshine Coast and ride the free shuttle to and from the festival site. This Park & Ride service will run throughout the day/night. Parking fees TBA. Parking locations around the coast to be confirmed soon.

### **Can I drop off or pick someone up at the festival?**

The new Park & Ride system alleviates pressure on the roads and creates a safer and more efficient transport system for all. This means there will be no vehicle pick-ups or drop offs allowed at the festival site (same as the Big Pineapple Music festival). Instead, simply park your car or get dropped off at one of many Park & Ride locations around the Sunshine Coast and jump on a free bus to the festival. Buses will return to these locations after the event. More details to be confirmed soon.

Parking and walking along the highway is dangerous and security/police will enforce this for everyone's safety.

## **Will there be...**

### **Will there be food at the show?**

Definitely! There will be a great variety of food stalls available.

### **Will there be ATMs at the show?**

Yes, ATM machines are available within the festival grounds.

### **Will there be first-aid available?**

Yes, there will be a first aid area at the show. Our friends, RED FROGS will also be there to rehydrate you if you get into trouble.

### **Will there be merchandise for sale?**

Yes definitely! There will be a stall at the show where you can purchase all artist merchandise. There will be lots of official Tash merchandise.

## **What should I bring?**

**ID** - as the festival is over 18 years only, you must present your ID on entry to the festival to validate age. Acceptable forms of identification are: DRIVERS LICENCE, PASSPORT, AUST POST KEYPASS and PROOF OF AGE CARD in accordance with liquor licensing laws.

**Any medication you require** - remember to include your contact details on any medication in case it gets lost and can be handed in.

**Money and tickets.** Sun protection including hat and sunscreen.

**Wet weather gear** - if it's forecast to rain, as the festival will continue if it's raining. For safety reasons UMBRELLAS ARE NOT ALLOWED INTO THE SHOW.

**Seating** - you can bring a picnic rug, collapsible camping chair, and inflatables however these must not be within 100m of the stage.

## **At the Show**

### **Are pass-outs permitted?**

For the safety of all patrons, there are strictly NO pass-outs at Concert. This means once you leave the concert, your wristband will be removed and you will be unable to gain entry back into the festival. If you believe that you have a legitimate reason to leave the festival and come back, please email us to discuss your circumstances. We thank you for your understanding and hope to make this the most amazing day for you.

### **Can I bring food, drink or alcohol into the festival?**

No food is to be brought into the Concert. If you have allergies that require food to be brought please explain your situation to security at the front gates.

Sealed bottled water may be brought into the festival, but we have bottled water for sale and free water onsite so it's not really necessary!

All bags will be searched on entry by security. **UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES CAN ALCOHOL BE BROUGHT INTO THE SHOW** under licensing laws which govern the show.

### **Entry Conditions**

All bags will be searched by security on arrival. For safety reasons, no bags larger than 40x40cm will be allowed into the concert. On-site police also reserve the right to conduct their own searches.

There will also be a zero-tolerance policy for illicit drugs. If you get caught with any illicit substances you will spend the night in the lockup and miss all the fun.

If you are under the influence of drugs or alcohol you will be refused entry. For the safety of all patrons we have the right to refuse entry where we see fit.

There will be high fencing patrolled by security guards surrounding the show, so forget about trying to sneak in. Police will deal with any offenders.
