FOOD & BEVERAGES: A variety of hot and cold food, coffee, alcoholic and non alcoholic beverages, confectionery and ice creams are available to purchase at the concert or pre-order a picnic hamper from Mustard Catering. For more information call Mustard Catering on (08) 9367 6331.

NOT PERMITTED: Strictly NO BYO alcohol and NO glass items. This is a fully licensed event. No tables or umbrellas, professional cameras, video or recording equipment, metal cutlery, wine spikes, tents or sun shelters. Perth Zoo is a smoke

free venue.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY: All bags are subject to a safety and security search upon entry. Prohibited items will be confiscated.

PARKING: Paid parking is available at the corner of Labouchere and Richardson Roads and off Mill Point Road and just north of the main entrance on Labouchere Road. Disability parking is available at the small Zoo car park adjacent to the Zoo entry on Labouchere Road and in the Mill Point Road car park – both are a short, flat distance from the Zoo's entry.

TICKET COLLECTS: Tickets can only be collected at a designated box office at the main entrance just prior to the gates opening – from 5pm (Please note tickets will not be available from Perth Zoo prior to 5pm). ZOO: Perth Zoo is a 10 minute drive from the Perth CBD. Entry to the venue is via the Zoo's main entrance, Gate 2, on Labouchere Road, South Perth.
