- Ticket owners must be present at Man O'War Steps, The Rocks at the above relevant check in time depending on the session with your ticket (i.e. TicketFast printed ticket).
- The ferry will leave for Goat Island at 9:30am sharp and 1:30pm sharp depending on what session you have obtained a ticket for. The ferry will not wait for anyone.
- After you have participated in the event, you must be present at the Goat Island Wharf at the above relevant check out time depending on the session with your ticket (i.e. TicketFast printed ticket) for the return journey.

Terms and Conditions

1. Entry for the event is only admitted on presentation of a ticket. Please retain your ticket at all times as your ticket is required for the return ferry journey to Man O'War Steps.
2. Please be aware that you can participate in a number of activities such as chocolate apple making, fairy floss making and cupcake making. If you have an allergy of any kind, please exercise caution. If you have any doubt, do not participate in the activity and you do so entirely at you and your dependents own risk.
3. The tickets are non-transferable and cannot be exchanged or refunded. Subject to availability, ticket holders may be able to obtain tickets for other sessions on www.ticketmaster.com.au.
4. Patrons must adhere to all instructions given by event staff at all times. The event may be cancelled in the situation of severe weather or bad ocean conditions. For the latest updates please visit www.cravesydney.com.
5. Cooking equipment, pop up tents/marquee; firearms, weapons, fireworks or other items deemed or considered dangerous are not permitted on Goat Island.
6. Please refrain from bringing glass on Goat Island.
7. Animals are not permitted on Goat Island (guide dogs are permitted).
8. No illicit drugs are to be brought on Goat Island.
9. Police, rangers and security may be patrolling Goat Island at times.
10. Video and still cameras are permitted but images may only be used for private purposes and not for commercial purposes or public display.
11. Patrons offer consent to be included in film and sound recordings of the event and for these recordings to be used by Destination NSW.
12. You acknowledge that you will be responsible for any loss or damage to the property (including personal property such as bags, money or other personal items) brought on Goat Island by you or your invitees.
13. You will be liable for any loss or damage caused at the event by you or your invitees. Destination NSW and its event producer and contractors will not be liable in any circumstance except as required by law.
14. You must ensure that you and your invitees act in an orderly manner when attending the event. We may refuse entry or evict you or any of your invitees if they are behaving in a disorderly, offensive or inappropriate manner.
15. If you lose your ticket, please contact Ticketmaster for a replacement ticket. An administration fee may be charged.
16. Tickets cannot be sold either privately or publicly via eBay, Gumtree or any other such online selling system. Tickets found to be sold will be automatically cancelled and/or the bearer of the ticket will be denied admission to the event.
17. Tickets cannot be used for advertising, promotional or other commercial purposes without the prior written consent of Destination NSW.
18. To the fullest extent permitted by law, we do not accept liability of any nature for the acts, omissions or default of those providing services in connection with 'Kids Crazy Island Tea Party' or any liability for any injury, damage, loss, delay or additional expenses which is incurred by you at or in association with this event. Where legislation implies any condition or warranty which cannot be excluded or modified, that condition or warranty will be deemed to be included in these terms and conditions. In no event will we be liable for any indirect, consequential, exemplary or special damages.

Event Tips

You can bring your own food and drink. Food and drink will be available for purchase on Goat Island.

We strongly recommend that you travel to Man O'War Steps via public transport. The nearest train station is Circular Quay. Man O'War Steps are located on the eastern side of the Botanical Gardens next to Sydney Harbour Opera House. Public transport is not included in this ticket. Please bring your wet weather gear as the event is an all-weather event except in the event of severe weather or bad ocean conditions when the event may have to be cancelled.

Please consider the environment as we want to create the smallest impact possible. You can make your picnic greener by ensuring that you:

- **Avoid bringing food packaging** – use recyclable plastic storage containers instead.
- **Buy produce that was locally produced in NSW.** Ask at your local Farmer's Market, supermarket or favourite deli. You will also be doing your bit to support our farmers and local suppliers.
